She will be meeting with parents and guardians after the first of the year.



Do you have a heart for foster children?

At this time, there are 185 children in Davidson County foster care, and the Davidson County Foster Elves need help in fulfilling their CHRISTmas wishes. Of course we can't give them what their hearts really want, but we can provide some of the material gifts for Santa to bring.

Foster parents receive a modest monthly stipend to help pay for food and clothing, but nothing extra for back-to-school, birthdays, holidays, etc. That's where the foster elves come in.

Foster elves are all volunteers. Some are individuals, some are families, others are coworkers or Sunday school classes. Some companies join us and take several lists, as do some churches and ball teams. All share a goal- to make CHRISTmas meaningful by bringing joy to area foster children and support those who provide a safe and loving home for them.

Elves from across the county are sent a child's wish list and purchase and wrap exactly what the child listed. The list will be detailed-- so there's no guesswork involved. We spend about \$50-75 on younger children, and up to \$150 for teens, since their clothes, shoes, "toys" are more expensive.

The wrapped and tagged gifts need to be delivered on or before December 4 to Meadowview Presbyterian Church in Lexington, where I'll check everything off. Then some friends and I will deliver all those gifts to DSS in early December, in time for the social workers to surreptitiously deliver them to each child's foster home before the big day.

If you'd like to help, but not shop, that's okay! You can send a donation to Meadowview Presbyterian Church (1 Grace Way, Lexington, NC 27295) and my Super Shopper Elf will shop and wrap for you.

Donations can be large or small - it's up to you.

Please share this with your family, friends, neighbors, coworkers, FB group, church group and leaders-- anyone you know with a heart for children! I am amazed each year by the response from our community, and beyond.


