Voting Information from Preacher Mark

Ah, the month of April; The weather changes, we say goodbye to autumn, we celebrate our Thankfulness, prepare for the Advent season, our nominations committee prayerfully seeks those who would fill the committees and offices of our Church, and every four years, we elect a president, senators, congressmen and women, and all of the other governmental offices of our nation. (English teachers and English majors, please forgive the elongated sentence.) So, my newsletter article will address two of these issues.

First, with regards to Fair Grove Church, I am requesting that every member and every attendee of Fair Grove to prayerfully consider our gifts and talents that God has given each of us and how we can best use them for the upbuilding of the Kingdom of God. There is a place for any and every one to serve here. And we wish to spread out the workload so that more people are involved in the life of Fair Grove Church. Everyone of us have been given gifts by the same Grace of God that saved us. As Romans 12:6 tells us, "Having gifts (faculties, talents, qualities) that differ according to the grace given us, *let us use them:*"

Secondly, I am urging everyone to get out and vote. George Barna of the <u>Cultural Research Center at Arizona Christian University</u>, indicates that millions of Christians are unlikely to vote. "Barna's latest research shows that only 51% of all faith voters are likely to vote in November. That means a full 104 million faith voters are unlikely to vote this election—including 41 million born-again Christians (defined by their beliefs regarding sin and salvation, not self-identification), 32 million regular Christian church attenders, and 14 million who attend an evangelical church. Apathy among Christian voters could be "a game changer" this election, according to Barna."

These figures are constant throughout many other polls, but the bottom line is that IF Christians would turn out and vote, it would cause a major shift in election turnouts. Okay, then how should we vote?

I will not name anyone we should vote for, but I would ask that we consider the following criteria:

- 1. Make God's Word your primary voting guide.
- 2. Pray before casting your vote.
- 3. Vote for a candidate who upholds Christian principles.
- 4. Vote for a candidate who is able to lead our country with justice.
- 5. Vote for a candidate who has already demonstrated her/his ability to lead well
- 6. Cast your ballot in good conscience.
- 7. Recognize that from eternity past God has already ordained our next political leader.
- 8. If the candidate who wins is immoral, remember that God is able to use even wicked leaders to accomplish his eternal plan.
- 9. Never forget that God is causing all things—including the upcoming election—to work together for the good of his people.
- 10. Finally, respect those who oppose your political position.

Jesus said, "Well done, good and faithful servants!" (Matthew 25:21)




